

Rodrigo Londoño Echeverry - President of the Comunes party

Mr. Londoño was a member of the Communist Youths (JUCO) and studied in the Patricio Lumumba University in Moscow. He also spent time in former Yugoslavia and Cuba. He joined the FARC–EP in 1982, and commanded fronts in southern Meta and Caquetá departments. Later, he led the Magdalena Medio block. Mr. Londoño became a member of the Central Command of the FARC-EP in 1986 and became Commander of the organization in 2011. He currently is the President of the *Comunes* political party.



Julián Gallo Cubillos – Senator, Comunes party

Mr. Gallo was a member of the Communist Youth (JUCO) and the Communist Party before joining the FARC-EP. In 1983 he was assigned as head of the Antonio Nariño Front, which had under his command all the urban structures that operated in Bogotá and in Cundinamarca department. Between 2000 and 2002, he was part of the FARC-EP negotiating team during the peace talks in San Vicente del Caguán with Andrés Pastrana's administration. Mr. Lozada also participated in the Havana talks as part of the Technical Sub-Commission for the End of the Conflict since July 2015. Currently, Mr. Lozada is a member of the National Political Council of the *Comunes*

party and, owing to the seats allocated to the party under the Peace Agreement for two consecutive congressional terms (2018-2022, 2022-2026), a member of the first commission of the Senate –which deals with Constitutional affairs–.
